**Call Meeting to Order**

2025 Draft Budget

Dave Staehle noticed the draft budget for 2025 in the expenses section contains the projected expenses for the pickleball tournament of \$3,400 was repeated twice. So, the total projected expenses is not 414, 535.00. It is \$11,135.00. The total revenues is \$12,688.00. So there is no deficit in our draft budget.

Billy Bowman mentioned the draft budget should include the projected revenues and expenses for our upcoming 10th anniversary.

Treasurer Paul Haring will correct the draft budget to reflect the correction of the expenses section and add the 10th year anniversary revenues and expenses.

## **Standing/Special Committee's Report**

### **Pickleball at the Beach Tournament & Liability Insurance**

David Staehle, our pickleball tournament chair, informed us of the location of our next Pickleball Tournament in September 2025 will be held at the pickleball courts next to the Clayton Elementary school. We need a certificate of insurance (COI) to cover any injury incurred during the two day tournament based on the injury inflicted by the environment, not for any injury inflicted during playing the pickleball games. The players will sign a waiver for injuries. Fred Hartman and Jay Innes shared with him the info regarding COI. It will be about \$250 to purchase (COI) for the two day event.

Billy Bowman (Mike Childs) moved for the DDSC pickleball committee to be given \$250.00 to purchase COI. Passed.

Billy Bowman requested for the pickleball committee to decide where the proceeds from the tournament go to which fund(s).

Dave Staehle will share more information during our next meeting. He said we will start making announcements regarding our pickleball tournament on April 18, 2025.

### **DDSC 10th Anniversary- Co-Chairpersons: Mike Childs & Denis Munn**

Mike shared what the committee has been working on deciding whether to have appetizers or not. He will keep us posted of more details during the next DDSC meeting.

### **Potential Presentations/ Workshops- Workshop Chairperson Billy Bowman**

Billy Bowman had met with his committee to make plans for the future DDSC workshops/presentations.

Potential workshop/presentations:

-Deaf Any by Ben Bahan focusing on different Deaf related information such as history, culture, ASL and more.

-Kristyn Eck, MSW: Columbus Colony Elderly Care, She used to work for the Columbus Colony Elderly Care for 25 years. Topics: Celebration of Life, funeral and memorial service planning (Zoom platform)

-Kim Majeri, MBA, MA: Gallaudet University Congressional Liaison (previously worked at NAD as their Legislative Coordinator and liaison for Deaf senior citizens). Topics: Preparing personal documents, choosing residential facilities (assisted living, memory care, nursing homes) focusing on accessibility and caregivers, their qualifications and duties- what to look for when choosing a caregiver.

She is willing to work with us to create a legislative bill focusing on Deaf elderly care issues.

Steve Hlibok, MA: - Wills, Trusts, Power of Attorney, and more.

Billy Bowman shared his experience attending the recent Legislator Breakfast Talk with several DDSC members. This breakfast talk was hosted by Senator Houck. Senator Houck had donated \$500 to DDSC for two straight years. They shared their issues with Senator Houck. Billy Bowman had sent him a summary of the issues the Deaf community faces especially the elderly care for the Deaf. He emphasized the importance for us to develop relationships with our state and federal legislators.

Billy Bowman was asked to share the next breakfast talk with Senator Houck. He had done it via the Eastern Shore Deaf WhatsApp group. He will inform us when it is held next time. He mentioned there is a town hall coming up during the summer in Millsboro.

Linda Lytle shared what she had done, she has been sending emails to the legislators and calling them. She encouraged us to do the same.

Jerald Cohen wanted for us to contact our legislators regarding this house bill: HB 53. This house bill deals with the communications during emergency situations. He's willing to share his letter with us to be used as a template.

Billy Bowman wants for DDSC to work collaboratively with Delaware Association of the Deaf (DAD) on any legislative related bills or writing bills. We need a person to serve as our legislative liaison working with DAD. He also suggested for both organizations to create a legislative committee.
